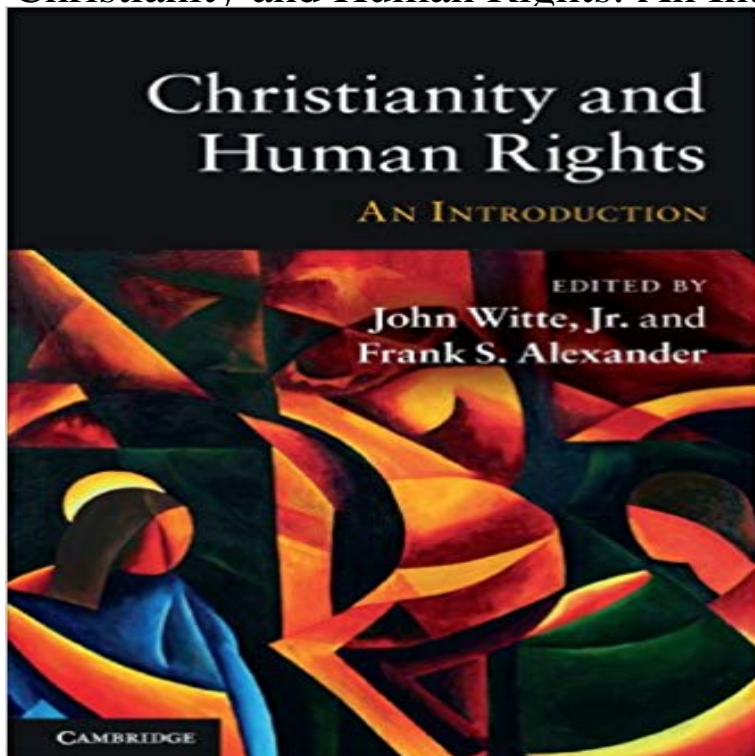


Christianity and Human Rights: An Introduction
