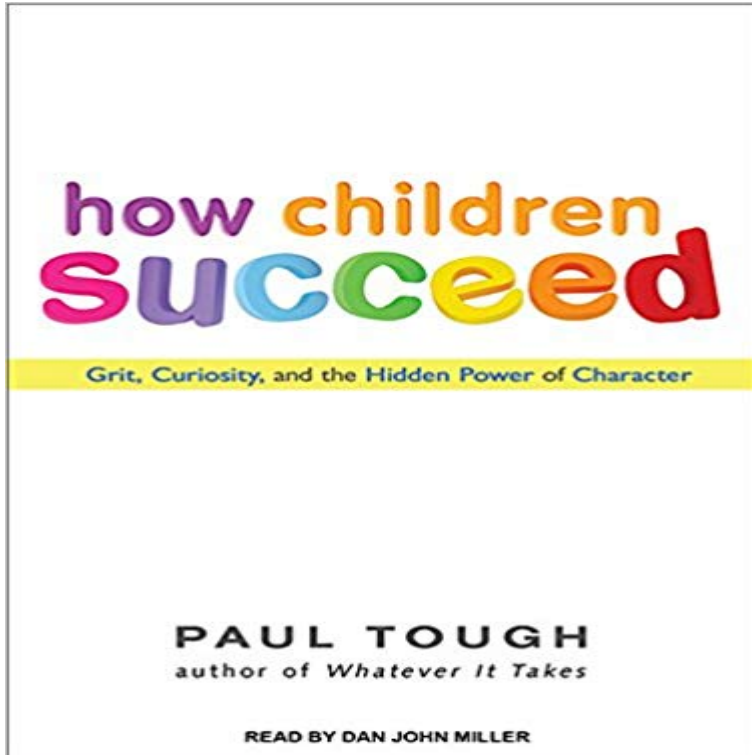


How Children Succeed: Grit, Curiosity, and the Hidden Power of Character
