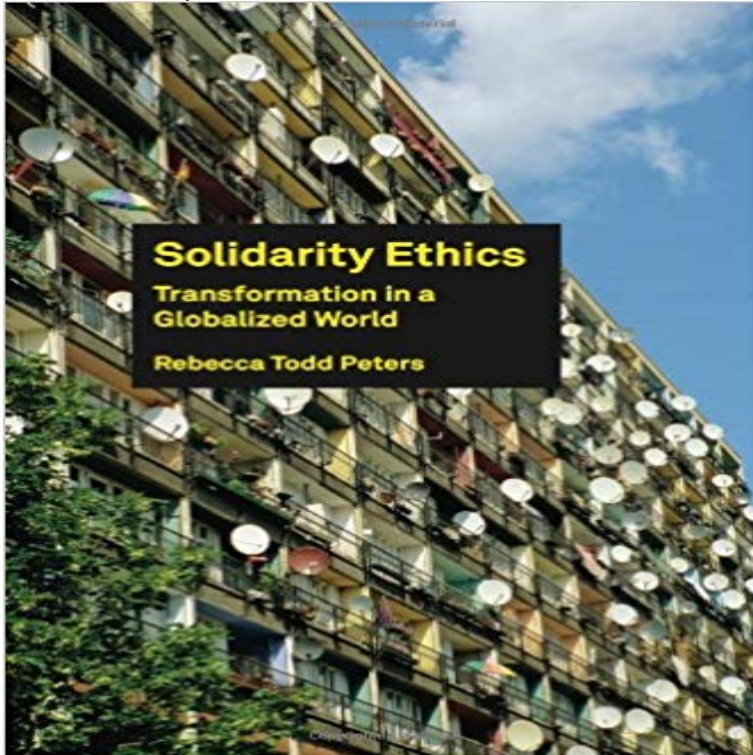


Solidarity Ethics: Transformation in a Globalized World
