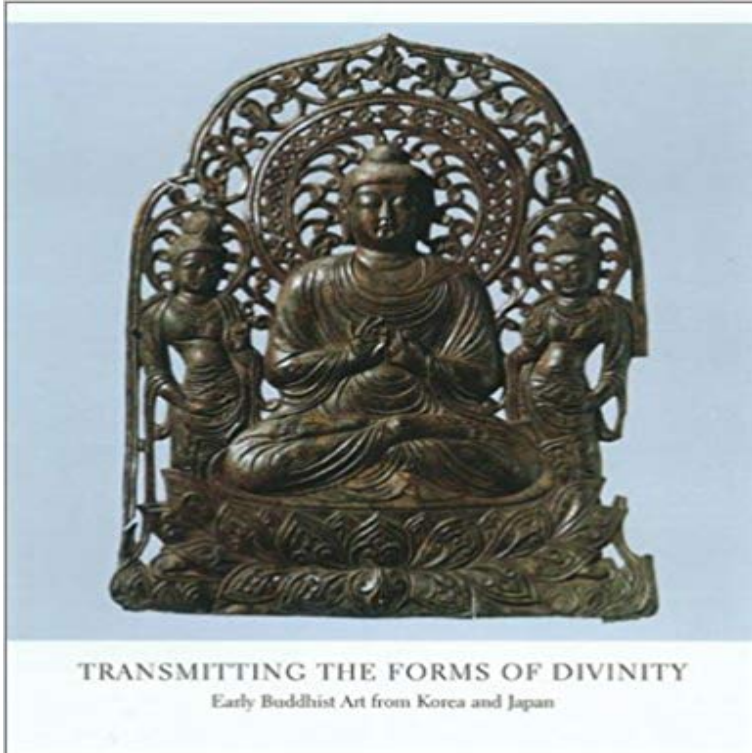


Transmitting the Forms of Divinity: Early Buddhist Art from Korea and Japan
